Our Mission

St Paul's Lutheran School exists to assist the parents of our congregation and community by providing academic excellence in the light of God's Word in a safe and loving environment in order to prepare our students for life and eternity.

Who Are We?

- St. Paul's Lutheran Church has been offering Christian education for more than 120 years!
- Programs for grades K4-8. K4 & K5 are separate grades. Grades 1-8 are combined in multi-grade classrooms. We do split grades 1-2 for reading each day.
- Experienced staff that is dedicated to their students and our school
- Participating in the School Choice programs (MPCP & WPCP) since 2018
- Affiliated with the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod (WELS)
- Member of the Wisconsin Lutheran High School Conference

Academics

- The Salutatorians at Cudahy HS in 2016 & 2017 were graduates of St. Paul's Lutheran School.
- Students have gone to many high schools in the area and made the honor roll -at Cudahy, St. Francis, South Milwaukee, Whitnall, Thomas More, Wisconsin Lutheran, University School, and Oak Creek.
- We have a fairly traditional approach to academics. We use the SuperKids reading series in our lower grades.
- As a Lutheran school we do put a high emphasis on religion and the study of God's Word. Devotions and religion classes are included in the daily schedule of each classroom.

Extra-Curriculars

- Sports: Volleyball, Cross Country, Basketball, Wrestling, and Track
- Academic Competitions: Math Meets, Spelling Bees, Geography Bee, and Forensics
- School Musical every other year
- Yearly Fair: Rotation of Art, Science, Writing, and Social Studies

School Day

The school day at St. Paul's runs from 8:00 AM - 3:15 PM.

Before & After School Care

We do offer Before & After School Care for the students of our school. The cost is \$2.50 per half hour.

Parent Involvement

Our parent group provides opportunities to get involved with various activities and events during the school year. Each year we hold a Grandparents Day event, a Fall Festival & Fundraiser, and a Book Fair.

Hot Lunch

We do NOT offer hot lunch on a daily basis at our school. We do have hot lunch once each week on Wednesday. Students have the option of taking the hot lunch at a cost or bringing their own lunch.

Tuition

Tuition is charged for each student attending St. Paul's Lutheran School. Rates for 2019-20 are as follows:

Families from St. Paul's	\$1550 for the first two children in grades K-8 \$850 for each additional child
Families from the Community	\$2050 for the first two children in grades K-8 \$1250 for each additional child
Families from other WELS Cong.	\$4050 for the first two children in grades K-8 \$2050 for each additional child
Pre-Kindergarten (K4)	\$850 for the 2 morning program (\$1650 for full day) \$1250 for the 3 morning program (\$2450 for full day) \$1650 for the 5 morning program (\$3250 for full day)

FACTS Tuition

Families have the option of paying their tuition in a number of ways including the following:

1. Payment in full at the start of the school year.
2. Two payments - ½ at the start of the year and the second ½ in January.
3. If payment is not made in one of the above ways, families are asked to set up a FACTS plan where a monthly amount is taken directly from their bank account. Options are 8 or 10 month plans.
