

SCHOOL CHOICE

Enrollment for 2019-2020

St. Paul's Lutheran School participates in both the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program (MPCP) and the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP). Students are eligible for the program based upon two criteria (1) residency and (2) income.

- Families that live in Milwaukee and meet the income requirements must apply for the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program (MPCP).
- Families that live outside of Milwaukee must apply for the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP).

The basic process is:

- Go to the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction website to find the student application forms:
 - <https://apps4.dpi.wi.gov/ChoiceParent/>
- Complete the online enrollment form for the program for which you qualify based upon your residency and income. The online forms are only available from the 1st through the 20th of each month. Applications for St. Paul's must be completed in February, March or April in order to obtain a seat.

Once you have completed the Wisconsin DPI application you must do the following:

Bring DPI required supporting documents to St. Paul's during the open enrollment period. (Remember, the enrollment period runs from the 1st through the 20th!) The required documentation includes the following:

- **Proof of Income Eligibility** (Required only of students new to the program). Information about income eligibility can be found on the Wisconsin DPI website:

- **Proof of Residency** (Required of all students each year they participate). Information about residency documentation can be found on the Wisconsin DPI website:

If your child receives a seat through the Choice program you will be asked to provide the following before the beginning of the new school year:

- A certified copy of the child's birth certificate for K4 students and anyone who did not attend St. Paul's the previous school year.
- A copy of immunization records for K4, K5, 6th grade and all new students to St. Paul's.

Additional forms will be completed at our all school registration in August.
