## Second Semester Mission Project: *Taste of Ethiopia*

The students of St. Paul's will be joining many of the other area Lutheran schools, along with Wisconsin Lutheran High School, in their annual Our Hands for His Service (OHFHS) project. The mission project will partner with a group called Pay It Forward Ethiopia which runs and operates a food truck called Taste of Ethiopia. In addition to providing food for children when they are at school, Pat and Tesfaye (a WLC graduate) Joyce are working toward creating a center called Lighthouse for Children, where children can go after school to be safe and to hear about a loving Savior named Jesus.

## SCRIP

SCRIP is an easy way to raise money for your school and yourself - 50% of the profit goes to school and 50% goes toward your child's tuition for next year. Orders can be dropped off in the school office on Fridays, and you may pick up your order on the following Friday in the school office. Simply fill out the form and send it in with a check payable to St. Paul's SCRIP. Some items can be purchased Friday mornings "to go" cash-n-carry.
