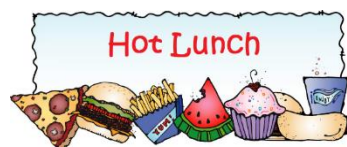

## **Second Semester Mission Project: *Taste of Ethiopia***

The students of St. Paul's will be joining many of the other area Lutheran schools, along with Wisconsin Lutheran High School, in their annual Our Hands for His Service (OHFHS) project. The mission project will partner with a group called Pay It Forward Ethiopia which runs and operates a food truck called Taste of Ethiopia. In addition to providing food for children when they are at school, Pat and Tesfaye (a WLC graduate) Joyce are working toward creating a center called Lighthouse for Children, where children can go after school to be safe and to hear about a loving Savior named Jesus. 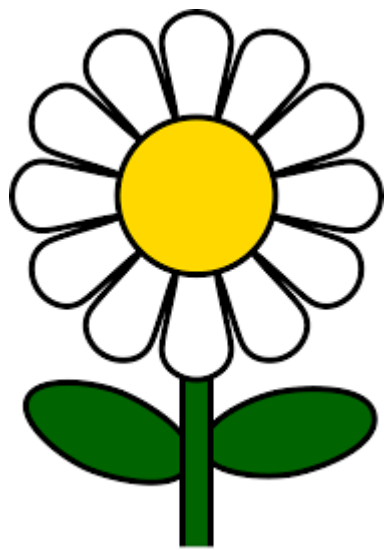

## **Report Cards**

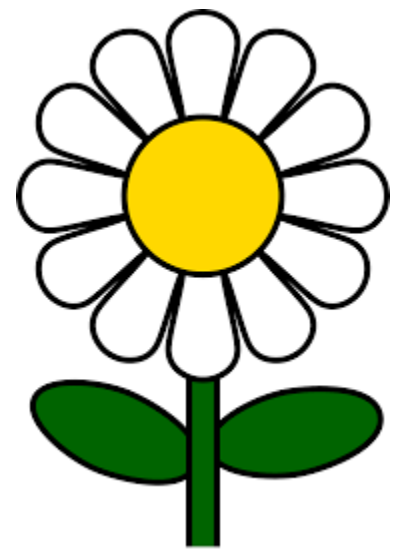
Third quarter report cards are being sent home today. Please sign and return the envelope as soon as possible.
